The Grade 2s are learning cursive, this week they will learn the upper and lowercase a, the Grade 1s are copying jokes in their best printing and the Grade 3s are writing sight words from printing into cursive. Miss Tracy has begun assessing the class to put them in new Words Their Way groups, and also has some government exams to administer.
