This week we continue to work on our handwriting, cursive and printing, Words Their Way and reading. We are working on list poems this week-a list poem is where you take a topic (which is your title) and then list words or phrases that describe your topic. With 25 days of school I am having to be creative, my students' attention spans are shorter than usual so we do an activity for a little while, and then change it up-this is absolutely normal for this time of the year. Pushing my students to do more than what they are capable of just results in frustration and we do not need that. In math I have divided my groups into smaller groups just to give my students what they need and to focus on some areas that need some attention. In science and social studies, we are using our time to practice for the Spring concert and we also put some papers into our binders. . . this is always an adventure. Wednesday and Tuesday next week I am away on some professional development, but a substitute is all lined up and ready for a wonderful day with my students. 
