### Grade 1, 2, 3 Classroom

This week the grade 1, 2 and 3s have been working hard towards our final push to the school year. We only have 30 days of school left and we are excited about summer vacation. This week the grade 1s and 3s wrote a joke for handwriting "What do you call a tiger that drinks lemonade? A sour puss." The grade 2s are practicing joining vowels to the cursive letter b as it takes some practice. We continue to do U.F.L.I. and the class is enjoying asking me why certain words are exceptions to the rules that they are learning, they are curious about words which makes my heart sing. We are reading, writing, creating words and breaking down words all while having fun. Some of the grade 3s and grade 2s are also doing novel studies, everyone gets what they need to succeed.

In math the grade 1 and 2 have been learning about all the different ways that we can write and show numbers- standard form, expanded form, base 10 blocks, money, using and place value. My students were surprised with the different ways, but soon realized that they knew all of them. In science we are talking about how things move, the speed that they can move and the direction- this is an introduction to physics. Our social studies has been put on hold for a little while as we are practicing for the Spring Concert. We can't wait to share our Reader's Theater stories with everyone! Today Aliza got a letter from our Great Canadian Mail Race- we shared it as a class and now Aliza is taking it home, maybe she will keep writing and have a new pen pal from Manitoba.
