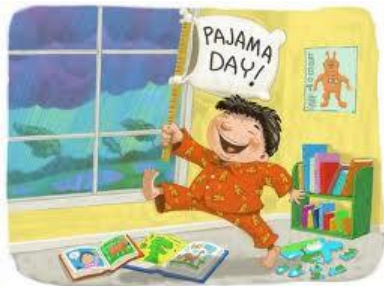

The Grade 1, 2 and 3 classes are off to another fabulous week! This week we are doing the letters Tt and Uu in cursive and printing. Very soon the Grade 3s will get a pen and will learn how to write in pen- they are growing up and will be in Grade 4 before they realize. The Grade 1, 2 and some of the 3s continue to work on A Sentence a Day, this is becoming too easy for them, so we will embark on a new writing adventure very soon. Reading is our focus this year, we have been reading every day and we will increase that amount in our classroom as the students build up more stamina.

In math the Grade 1 and 2 students are doing a lot of work with numbers- they are working on place value, adding and subtracting, word problems and money. This week the Grade 1s played store and are learning how to count back change. . . they quickly realized that it is just adding and subtracting! The Grade 2s have started a number line in the gym that will go to 1000! Both classes are making a lot of connections with numbers.

In science, the classes have started a new unit on the Properties of Materials and in social studies they have started a unit on India so that we can compare it to Canada. The class have seen their name in Hindi and have been excited to try and write it. Very soon it will be time to start our Christmas play- the class has picked a funny one! Please watch the newsletter for details, we hope that all of you can come!

This Thursday is Pajama Day! The Grade 1, 2 and 3 class wanted to have a Pajama Day with popcorn and a movie to celebrate the 40th Day of School which was last week. Zero the Hero decided to give our class a choice of what they wanted as a treat since the roads and weather were so bad the previous week.
