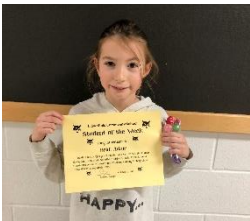

Due to COVID restrictions we have changed the hours we are open to the public. I can sign your books out to you and meet you at the door or the library pick-up window, which is located just to the right of the school's front doors ☺ Your book returns can be left in the drop box outside the door and will be emptied every Tuesday.
