If you are unable to access curbside pickup we have a huge selection of eaudio on the Libby app and ebooks on the Cloud Library app. Go to [www.prl.ab.ca](http://www.prl.ab.ca) and click on eLibrary. All you need is your library barcode and password to set up an account. Feel free to contact me if you don't have those.

We are still open Tuesdays from 12 - 6, the public can access curbside pickup during this time. On Thursdays we are open 12 - 5 p.m., curbside pickup during this time. For curbside please call or text Darvy @ 403-575-0366 or Lauraine @ 403-578-6097 or you can call the school 403-578-2247. I can sign your books out to you and meet you at the door or the library pick-up window, which is located just to the right of the school's front doors 😊 Your book returns can be left in the drop box outside the door and will be emptied every Tuesday. Returning books will be quarantined for 72 hours before being checked in. Thanks for your cooperation during these trying times.
