

you want to try them at home!

### Ginger Snap Cookies

3/4 cup butter

1 cup granulated sugar

1 Egg

1/4 cup molasses

2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour

2 tsp baking soda

2 tsp ginger

1 tsp cinnamon

1/2 tsp salt

Extra sugar for rolling cookies.

Cream butter and sugar. Beat in egg. Mix in molasses.  
Combine dry ingredients and add to wet mixture. Mix  
well, shape into 1 inch balls. Roll in sugar, place on  
greased or parchment lined baking sheet. Bake at 350  
for 10-12 minutes. Makes 3-4 dozen.

1 dozen ginger snap cookies  
1/4 box vanilla or graham wafer cookies  
Combine in food processor with 2tbsp butter or margarine. Press into bottom of 9x13 pan or 15 individual cups, reserving some crumbs for the topping.

### Cheesecake layer:

8oz softened cream cheese  
1 cup powdered sugar  
1 cup whipped topping  
Combine and spread evenly over crumb layer

### Pumpkin layer:

2 cups milk  
2 small pkgs vanilla instant pudding mix  
12oz (1 1/2 cup) pumpkin purée  
1 tsp cinnamon  
Combine and spread evenly over cheesecake layer

### Topping:

1 cup whipped topping  
Reserved cookie crumbs  
Refrigerate and enjoy! Makes 15 servings.
