The grade 1, 2 and 3 classroom is a busy place. This week we are doing our first spelling test, we are excited and nervous about that. This week we also started reading, we practice a page and then Miss Tracy listens to us read one on one. These pages will also go home so we get some extra practice, show our families, improve our fluency and to increase our confidence. The grade 3 class started the novel that they chose, The Mouse and the Motorcycle, once the grade 3 class is done reading this book we will watch the movie as a class, eat popcorn and have some pop or juice boxes. I know that everyone is excited, but please do not watch the movie early.

In math the grade 1 class is putting together numbers to 5, and today we watched a Number Blocks video about that. The grade 2 class asked their classmates a yes and no question, recorded their classmates' responses and then made a bar graph to show the results.

In science we talked about 4 types of clouds: Cirrus, Stratus, Cumulus, and Cumulonimbus and then used cotton to make representations on a piece of paper. This week we will be watching outside for the 4 types of clouds. In social studies we played a game with the 4 cardinal directions, we had to give directions to get the class to Murphy Mouse, and this week we will be drawing a map of our classroom. We are learning, growing and having fun!
