### Halloween Movie Night!

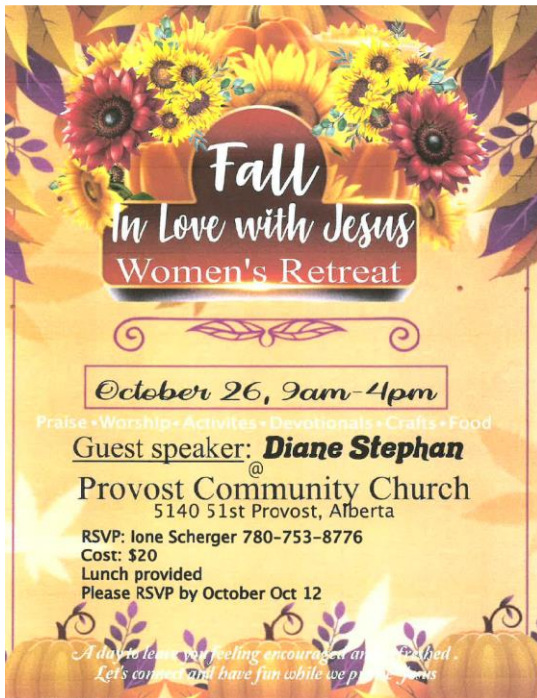
