WHEN WE READ, IT HELPS TO MAKE PREDICTIONS ABOUT WHAT WE THINK IS GOING TO HAPPEN BASED ON OUR KNOWLEDGE. PREDICTING KEEPS US INVOLVED IN WHAT WE ARE READING AND HELPS US COMPREHEND WHAT WE ARE READING. IN MATH WE LEARNED HOW TO COUNT ON TODAY, WE FIND THE BIGGEST NUMBER AND COUNT ON FROM THAT NUMBER, BUT THIS STRATEGY WORKS BEST WITH 1, 2 OR 3; WITH LARGER ADDENDS WE NEED TO USE A DIFFERENT STRATEGY. IN SCIENCE WE ARE TALKING ABOUT MATTER AND HOW IT TAKES UP SPACE (VOLUME), HAS MASS AND AREA. IN SOCIAL STUDIES WE ARE LEARNING THE PROVINCES AND THEIR CAPITAL CITIES. AS ALWAYS, WE ARE LEARNING, LAUGHING AND MAKING PROGRESS.
