GRADE 1-2-3

Report cards went home last week for the grade 1, 2 and 3 class and everyone is doing very well. Parent-Teacher Conferences were Monday after school and will also happen today. If those days did/do not work for you, then please contact Miss Tracy and we will make a time that will work.

The grade 1, 2 and 3 did some editing today, we looked at piece of writing and found missing capital letters, missing punctuation and some spelling mistakes. The students are also reading and drawing a picture to show what the story was about, this is one way to show that they are comprehending what they are reading. The class continues to work on writing, handwriting and last week we made a Preciting Pirate because when we read we should be predicting what could happen next, that keeps us involved in what we are reading and keeps us comprehending as well. In math we are working on the adding on strategy, the grade 2 class is finishing pie charts and the grade 1 class is working on finding the bigger number, smaller number and equal numbers. In science we are talking about what things are made of and in social studies we have looked at the cordillera (mountain) and prairie regions of Canada.




