GRADE 1-2-3

The grade 1, 2 and 3 classroom is always a busy place but with the Christmas season and the concert approaching, it is extra busy! We hope to see you at the concert in December

All three classes are making good progress with their printing and cursive. We continue to talk about predicting, we are reading, looking at words and their patterns, making words, talking about sentences, writing sentences and the grade 2 and 3 classes are editing and revising the sentences that they are writing. We are still working on sentences, but we are making progress. We have been learning about fairy tales with the kindergarten class and are very good at naming the characters, setting, beginning, middle, end and problem of the story; we have also talked about cause and effect.

In math we are learning/reviewing counting on and starting to work on doubles as an adding strategy. The grade 1 class is adding up to 10 and the grade 2 class is working on pictographs.

In science we are learning about different types of matter and what objects can be made from. In social studies we are reviewing the provinces and their capitals and have talked about the cordillera, prairies and arctic regions of Canada.

We continue to learn and grow and we have fun while doing it!
