GRADE 1-2-3

I need to apologise to the Easter Bunny who visited our classroom last Tuesday with delicious chocolate eggs for all of the students in grade 1, 2 and 3 class. Thank you for thinking of us, what a wonderful, thoughtful and delicious surprise!

As of today we have 40 days of school left! While we are all really excited, it is still important that we keep learning and making connections. I am SO proud of how my class comes to school happy, eager, patient and always willing to try their best. They are a FABULOUS group of learners! This week we started doing some non-fiction research writing, which is different from what we have been doing. We continue to do U.F.L.I. and printing/cursive writing, we are reading, and making words with morphology. In math we are stamping and using base ten blocks to represent numbers; the grade 2 class is making models to add two-digit numbers and the grade one class is working on fact families. In science we are looking at the properties of objects and comparing properties. In social studies we are talking about how natural resources affect a community. The jobs that our community has are because of our natural resources.
