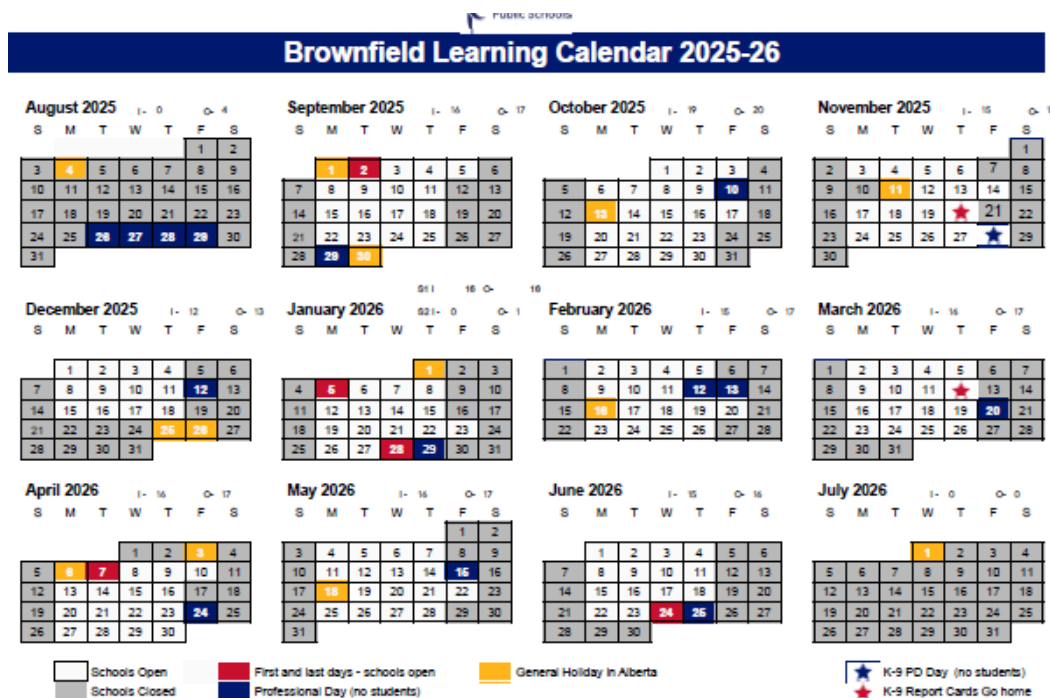


## E.C.S. AND PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION
